“WP” DISTILLERY PROFILE

Region: Jamaica
Founded: Lluidas Vale, Saint Catherine Parish, 1741
Note: part of a sugar estate founded in 1670, it was completely rebuilt in 2005

“Colour: gold.
Nose: old pears, tobacco and camphor, brine, warm cakes, toffee, sawn pinewood.
Mouth: creamy, toffee, overripe banana, brine and olives once more.
Finish: long, gritty, brine-y.

“Distilled in a double retort Pot still in an undisclosed distillery in the St Catherine Parish in Jamaica.
It is derived from the low ester production that employs 4 fermenters for a 30 hours fermentation, compared to the 2 fermenters - 1/3 weeks long fermentation of its high ester close brother. We didn't want an ester monster so we focused our attention to this style to showcase the effect of an almost complete tropical maturation (11 and ½ months) focusing on overripe fruits and spices, with a good balance between the typical banana and vanilla flavours.”
