"Nose: notes of tangerines, a touch of marzipan, a little butterscotch.  
Mouth: more tangerines again, spicy coconut, some sweet ginger  
Finish: not too short, with rather more vanilla. Strawberry sweets in the aftertaste.

"An old dignified Single Grain should always be part of a well-stocked whisky cabinet, it's the ideal bridge linking bourbon and scotch whisky. A similar mash bill, some differences in the distillation process and a completely different climate during maturation can highlight some of the most interesting aspects of the Scottish terroir. It is also one of the few last opportunities to taste an almost 40 years old scotch whisky without having to donate an organ: drink and be merry!"
